Articles of Policy of the Holistic Development Bureau

Official policy of the British Commonwealth ver. 1 established July 14, 2023

Article 1

The body corporate known as the Holistic Development Bureau is a public body of the British Commonwealth established by Commonwealth law.

Article 2

The individuals known as members and all such individuals as may at a later date be elected as members shall be known to constitute the public body.

Article 3

Objects of the public body include all activities as to ensuring members are holistically developed in line with meeting principles 13 and 15 of a creative society.

Article 4

The public body shall exercise all powers as needed to meet Article 3.

Article 5

The public body shall be governed by its members in the form of an appointed council, that is, the members define the strategic direction of the public body, but the union government has administrative powers and responsibilities.

Article 6

All assets and property of the public body with exception those owned by others are the assets and property of The Commonwealth Crown.

Article 7

The public body seeks to become profitable, but will also be financed from the Commonwealth Budget and by the Roerich Institute of Technology.

Article 8

The current Articles of Policy may only be changed by authority of the British Commonwealth and via official policy of the British Commonwealth.

Article 9

These are initial Articles of Policy and are aimed to be updated in the near future.
